Extenuating Circumstances Pertaining to Withdrawal

- Medical: Can be physical, mental, emotional, etc.
- Illness/Death in the immediate family: Family medical emergency (surgery, long-term illness diagnosis). Death of an immediate family member—parents, guardians, siblings, children, spouses, registered domestic partners—does not include grandparents.
- Military activation
- Unanticipated change in financial situation: Termination of main source of income, filing of bankruptcy, etc. Financial emergency does not include "did not understand what I was financially accountable for" or "not eligible for financial aid/did not receive a scholarship."
- Health or safety concerns with host country: Applicable if there is an elevation of a country's rank in Ohio State's tier system to Tier 3 or Tier 4 after admission but before departure.
- Other: Must be a circumstance out of the student's control with documentation.

Supporting Documentation

Documentation is required for all withdrawal requests. This may include, but is not limited to, a letter from an attending physician stating medical advice to not travel, documentation of immediate family member illness, death certificate, military activation orders including conflicting dates, letter of loss of job/primary income. If you are unable to provide this documentation, please write and attach a thorough narrative describing your situation alongside submission of this form.
