

#### The Oval


• The Oval is the heart of Ohio State's campus

Brutus has been Ohio State's official mascot since 1965




## **Social Security Number (SSN)**

- You should get an SSN if you are paid in the United States for tax purposes
  - Apply in person 14 days after arriving
- Social Security Administration
  - 200 N High St
  - Take the #2 bus south to downtown and get off on Spring Street

- Sign up for GLACIER
  - Taxes subtracted from Ohio State wages
- Human Resources will reach out within two weeks



# **Address reporting**

- Employee Self Service: Workday
  - Learn about updating your address with the university at <u>go.osu.edu/Address-Change</u>
- You **must** report a change of address within 10 days

#### **Health insurance**

- Required for all J-1s and J-2s throughout the entirety of your program
- Sign up as soon as possible
- Upload documentation into IntBuckeye J-1 Scholar Services
- For any issues or questions, please email oiainsurance@osu.edu
- Options:
  - Gallagher Accident & Sickness
  - Ohio State Health Plan (if applicable)
  - Government-sponsored, DOS-compliant health plan


## Scholar services appointments

- Appointments are available Monday-Thursday from 1-4 p.m.

  - Travel signature
  - Extension of program
  - Transfer of program
  - Driving
  - Departure

# J-1 program activities

- DS-2019 is specific to:
  - Your department
  - Work address
  - Funding amount, source
- You need a new DS-2019 before making any changes
- See a Scholar Immigration Specialist to make changes





## Your program and employment

- Approved for Ohio State and your department
- Occasional lecture or consultation
  - Paid or unpaid
  - Written permission needed from a Scholar Immigration Specialist two weeks in advance



# **Enrolling in classes**

- Cannot interfere with J-1 program
- Cannot earn credit for a degree
- Cannot be a J-1 scholar **and** a graduate associate
  - Teaching
  - Research
  - Administrative

## **Program extensions**

- Extension restrictions:
  - Maximum stay for J-1: short-term scholars: six months
  - Research scholars and professors: five years
  - 30-90 days before DS-2019 expires
  - Human resources professional in your department must start the process



## J-1 program transfer

- To conduct research at another university or hospital
- Discuss with the Office of International Affairs
- Need new institution's DS-2019
- No gaps between end and start dates
- Ohio State Transfer Form must be uploaded to J-1 departure form in IntBuckeye



### Departure

- 1-2 weeks before the end of your program, request J-1 departure to your department human resources
- Fill out J-1 departure form in IntBuckeye and notify your human resources contact

## **Grace period**

- 30 days to leave the United States
- Begins the day after your last day of your work/program
- Even for early termination of your program

## **Keep documents safe**

- Keep all past, present and future DS-2019s
- Keep passport, DS-2019, I-94 in a safe location
- Keep copies in a separate, safe location



## Have a valid passport

- Must always be valid six months into future
- Renew with your country's embassy




## J-2 dependents

- Dependents include your spouse and unmarried children under 21 years of age
- Must have health insurance
- May work with permission

# **International travel as a J-1 Exchange Visitor**







## **Travel signature**

- 15-minute appointment with a Scholar Immigration Specialist
- Sign DS-2019 for re-entry to the United States
- Make an appointment at <u>go.osu.edu/ScholarServices</u>

### **Re-entry to the United States: Valid visa**

- To return to the United States to continue with your J-1 program, you must have:
  - Valid visa
  - Valid passport
  - Valid and signed DS-2019
  - Proof of funding letter from department
- Traveling for more than one month requires permission with signed form
  - Learn more at go.osu.edu/Scholar-Travel

#### Canada, Mexico, Caribbean reentry: Expired visa

- Stay less than 30 days
- To return to the United States, you need:
  - A visa valid six months into future
  - Signed DS-2019
  - Previous I-94 card/printout
  - Proof of funding, support
  - Letter from department

# **Two-year home country return**

- 212(e)
  - Determined at the embassy
  - Return to home country for an aggregate of two years
  - If you might want to return with H, L, or immigrant visa in the future
  - Waiver is available, but approval will end the ability to extend J-1 visa program

# 24-month repeat participation bar


- You cannot begin a new J-1 Research Scholar or Professor program for 24 months
- Able to return as:
  - Short-Term Scholar
  - Tourist
  - Student



# **Personal safety**







### **Emergency phone number**

- Call 911
  - Used throughout the United States
  - Police, fire, ambulance
- If you have an emergency while on campus, you can use the blue light phones to call 911




#### **Seasonal weather**
