Introduction

The China Gateway is grateful for the continuous support from campus partners, alumni and friends over the last 12 years and looks forward to working with existing and new partners in 2023.

This year was filled with connections. The China Gateway was an integral part of connecting students to The Ohio State University and career resources; faculty and staff to partnerships with Chinese universities and corporations; and reconnecting alumni with old and new friends.

In 2022, the China Gateway established a high school counselors advisory board in collaboration with the Office of Strategic Enrollment Management. The board includes high school counselors from Beijing, Shanghai, Ningbo, Ji'nan and Wuhan and focuses on supporting Chinese students' transition from high school to college and through graduation.

Over 56 events relating to undergraduate and graduate program recruitment connected the China Gateway with 6,500 students. The China Gateway also assisted current Buckeyes and alumni with internship and full-time job opportunities and career fairs and workshops.

Engaging with alumni has always been an important goal for the China Gateway. With the six regional alumni clubs, the China Gateway hosted 25 virtual and in-person events, connecting with more than 350 Buckeyes and over 360 families and friends.

In 2023, the China Gateway will continue to connect students, faculty, staff, alumni and partners between Ohio State and China.

Students

The China Gateway supported Ohio State's undergraduate and graduate recruitment efforts by hosting in-person and virtual information sessions, visiting high schools and attending college fairs, such as those hosted by EducationUSA and the American Universities China Association (AUCA).

Recruitment

- Recruitment activities took place in several cities including Shanghai, Beijing, Kunshan, Suzhou, Changshu, Hangzhou, Ningbo and Guangzhou
- Attended 19 virtual and in-person undergraduate fairs with 1,143 attendees
- Spoke at one EducationUSA workshop with over 100 attendees
- Participated in 17 fairs and virtual information sessions to support the Fisher College of Business and Moritz College of Law's graduate recruitment; 1,018 people attended

Engagement

Provided resources to and engaged with students and scholars by hosting a virtual Pre-departure Orientation (PDO), two virtual events for admitted students, creating a high school counselor advisory board and connecting students to internships and job opportunities.

- Partnered with the Offices of Strategic Enrollment Management, Student Life and International Affairs to host a virtual PDO with 226 students and families
- Hosted two virtual yield events to welcome 84 newly admitted students and their families with the Offices of Strategic Enrollment Management and Student Life
- Created a high school counselor advisory board comprised of counselors from Beijing, Shanghai, Ningbo, Ji'nan and Wuhan to support Chinese students' transition from high school to college and through graduation
- Posted almost 500 internship and full-time job openings through various channels
- Organized two virtual career fairs and 14 career skills workshops connecting with 176 students and alumni
