The Sociology Department, with the generous assistance of the Sociology Advisory Board, has created a scholarship to assist Ohio State students who participate in study abroad programs led by sociology faculty. This summer, this includes “Genocide and Its Aftermath in Rwanda,” led by Dr. Hollie Nyseth Brehm, and “Research Central & Eastern Europe in Comparative Perspective - Social Sciences in Poland,” led by Dr. Kazimierz M. Slomczynski.

Scholarship applications are due on **March 1st** by 5:00 p.m. Applications for consideration for the scholarship for the Rwanda program should be **emailed** to brehm.84@osu.edu, while applications for consideration for the scholarship for the Poland program should be emailed to slomczynski.1@osu.edu. The scholarship will provide up to **\$500** to go toward covering the cost of the respective program.

Applications will be assessed on both merit and need-based criteria, and all information provided will remain confidential. **Sociology and Criminology majors will be given priority, but all Ohio State students are eligible for the scholarship.**

3. A short (one page, single-spaced) statement describing 1) why you applied to the selected study abroad program, 2) how you anticipate the program will affect your achievement of your career goals and/or influence your sociological training at OSU, and 3) your financial need.

Recipients of the scholarship will be notified in mid March and will receive additional information about how to claim the scholarship at that time. Please note that if you receive this scholarship, you will be required to write a short (one page, single-spaced) statement after the study abroad experience that explains what you learned and how this experience will contribute to your career goals and/or broader sociological development. This statement should be submitted to the respective study abroad leader (Dr. Nyseth Brehm or Dr. Slomczynski) no more than **one month** after the program has ended.
